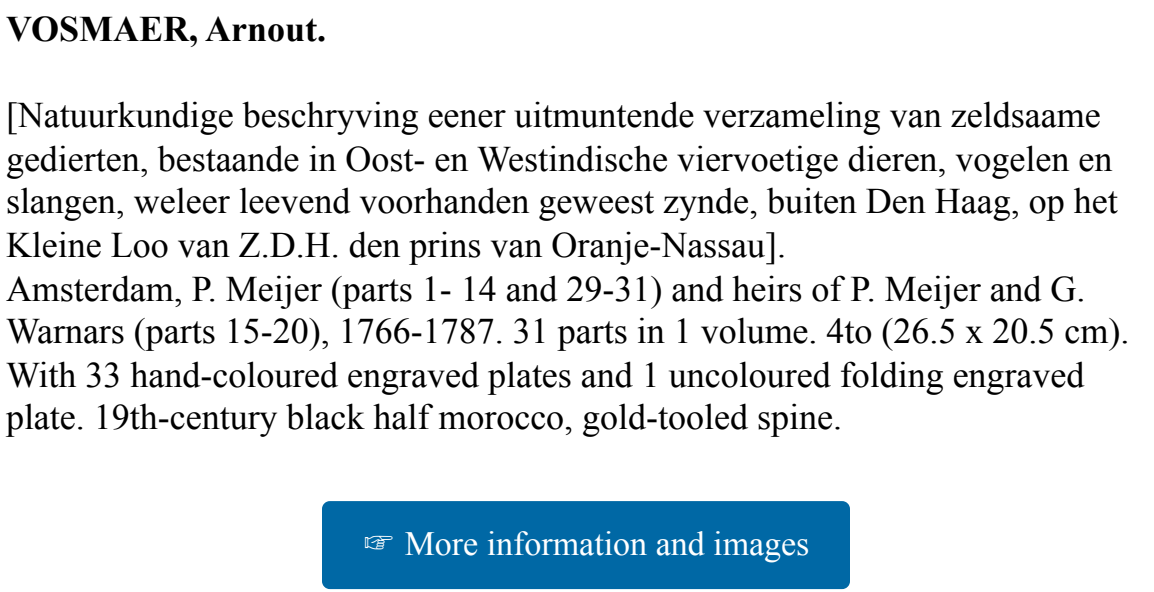

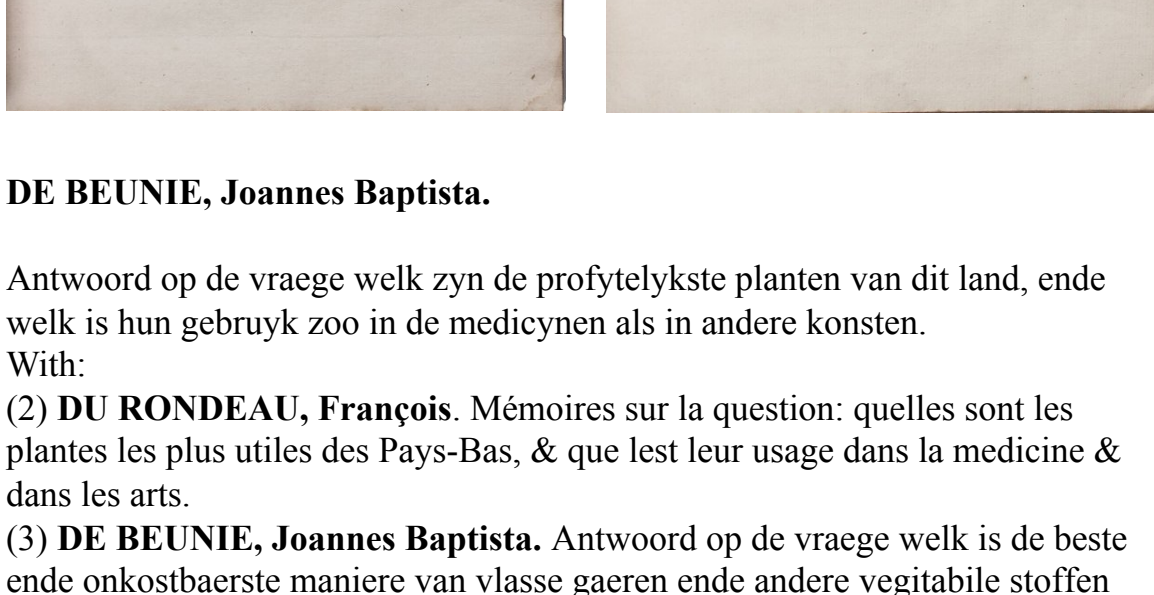

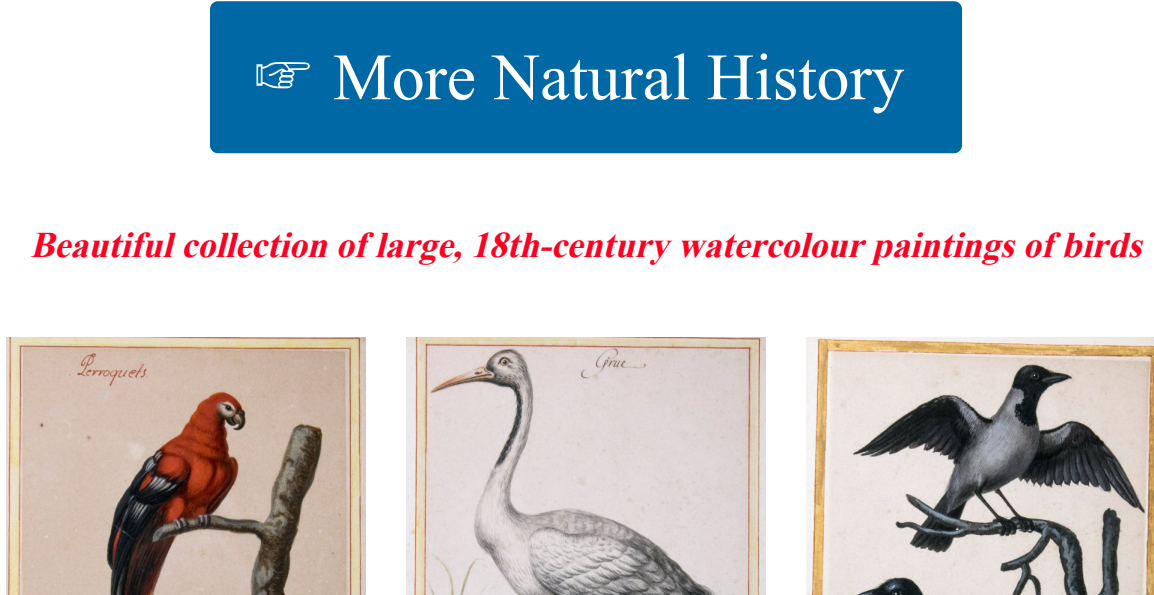

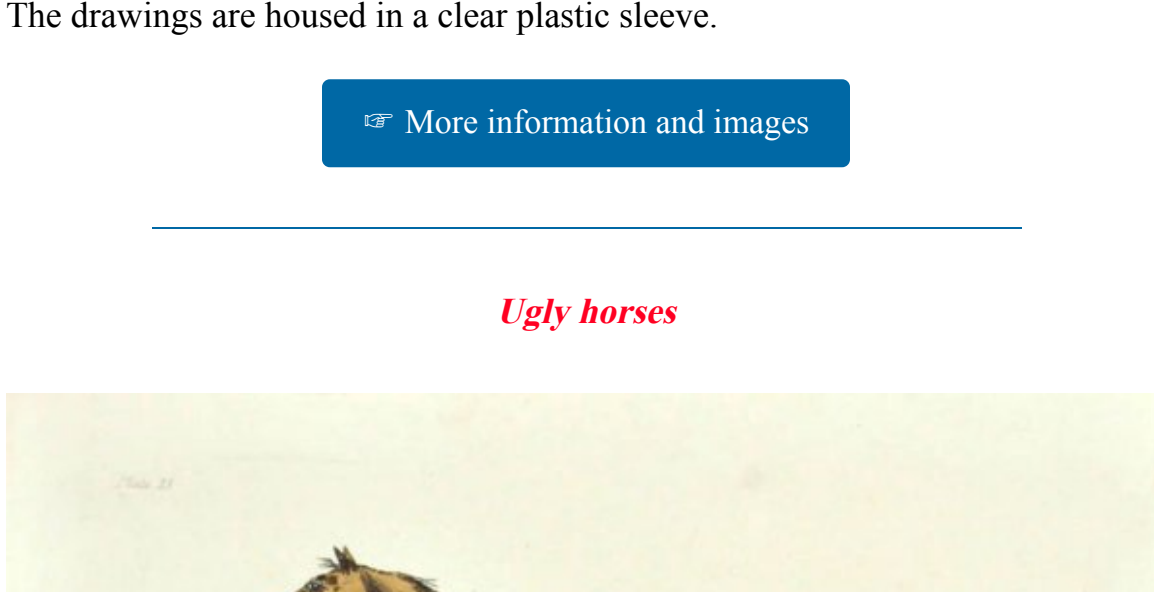

#### Beautiful collection of large, 18th-century watercolour paintings of birds

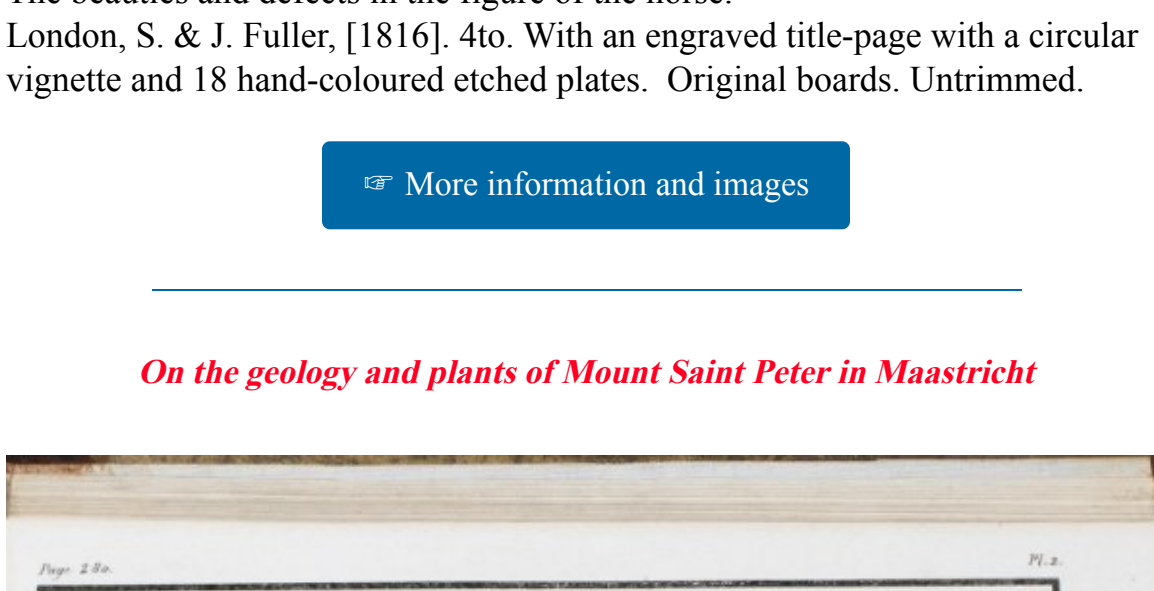

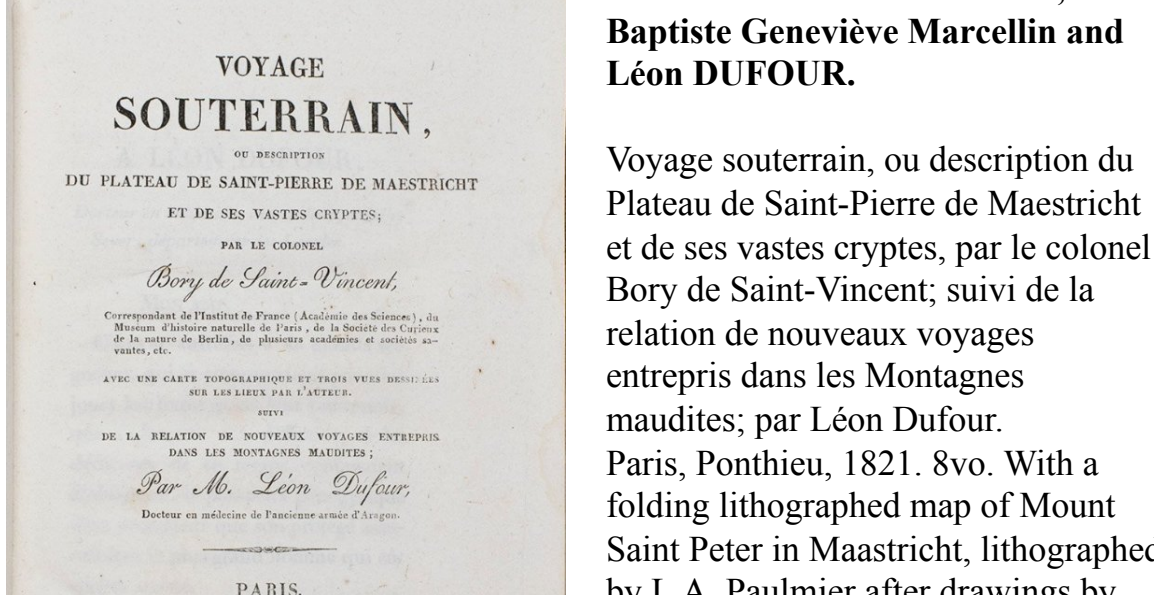

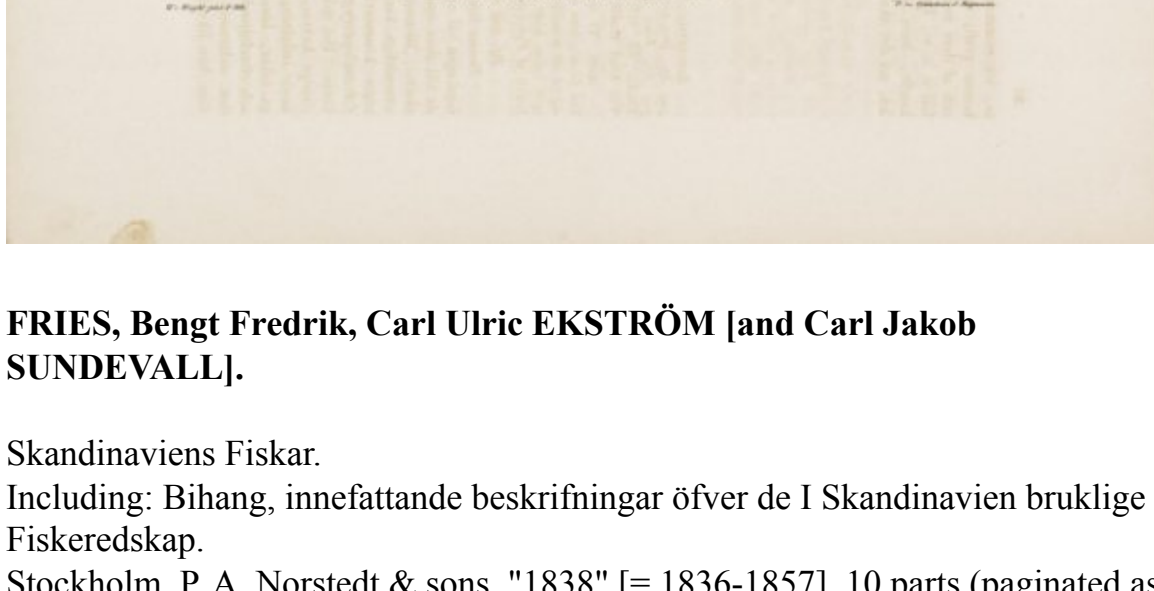

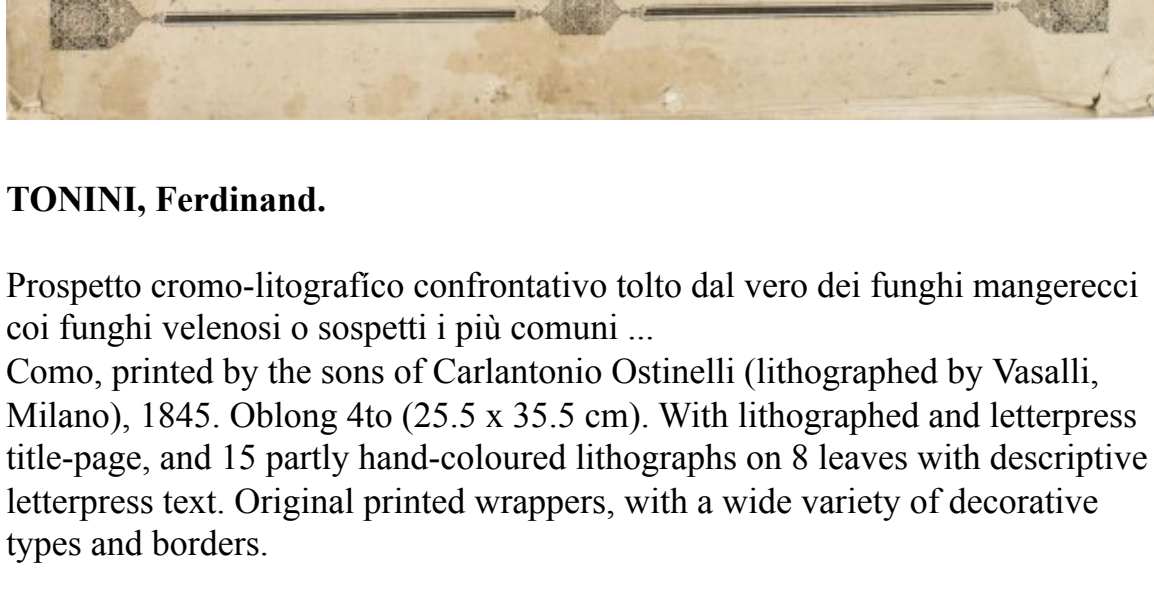

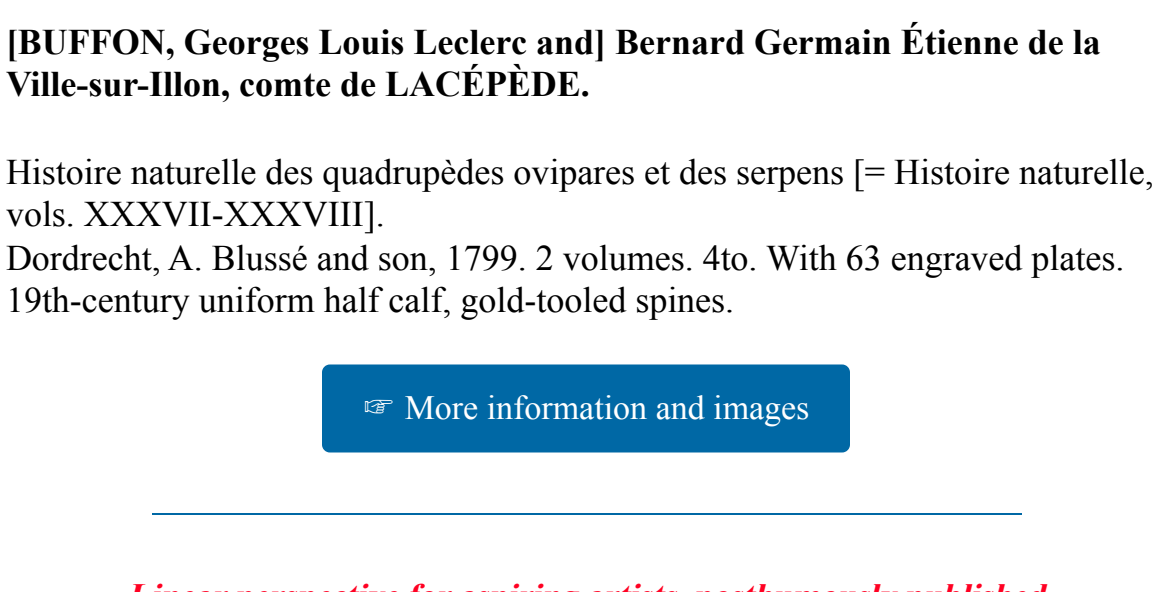
