Bergen op Zoom, Jacob Canin, 1605. 4to.

Important pamphlet relating to historical events in Bergen op Zoom which occurred in 1605. In that year, the troops of the Archduke Albert of the Southern Netherlands executed three surprise attacks on the city: on March 18, August 22 and September 19 (the last two under the command of Du Terrail), all without result. The nightly attack on the stronghold in June 1606 had no success either. On the instigation of Prince Maurits reinforcements on the stronghold were installed from that year on.

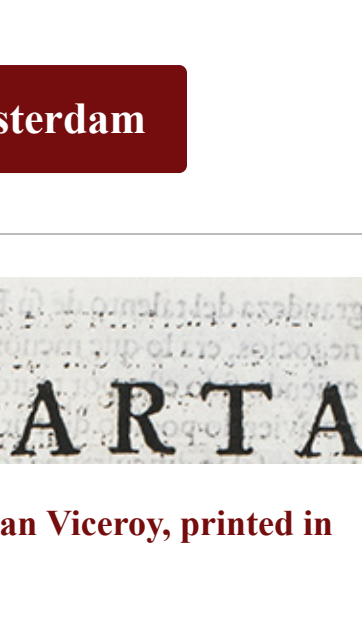
Vier Amsterdamsche Burgers :
Waermondt, Geerlof, Strouthart, en Hebrecht.

Important Orangist pamphlet of the "Doelopersbeweging" against the Amsterdam Patriciate and nepotism in September 1672

[ORANGIST MOVEMENT].
Dam-praetje tusschen vier Amsterdamsche Burgers: Waermondt, Geerlof, Strouthart en Heb-recht. Handelende van de oude privilegien, vryheden, en gerechtigheden van de burgery en schutterij.

[Amsterdam], voor de Doele-schutters, 1672. 4to.

Important pamphlet originating in the so-called "Doelopersbeweging", a democratic and Orangist movement against the Amsterdam Patriciate with its nepotism and autocratic structures during September 1672, the "Rampjaar" (Disaster Year) of the Republic of the Seven United Netherlands. In this year, the Dutch Republic was attacked by England, France, and the dioceses of Cologne and Munster. The two regents at the time, the brothers Johan and Cornelis de Witt, were publicly murdered by a rebellious and furious crowd in The Hague. These were turbulent times and the production of pamphlets was higher than ever as a result.

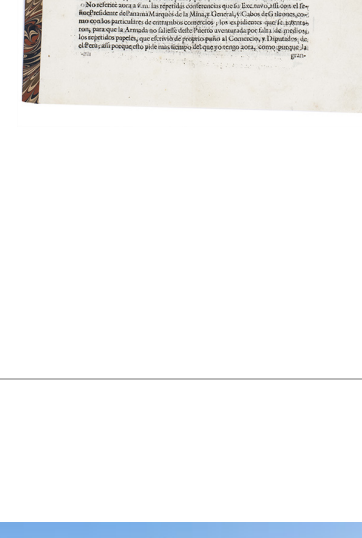
COPIA DE CARTA

News from Portobello of the death of a Peruvian Viceroy, printed in Lima

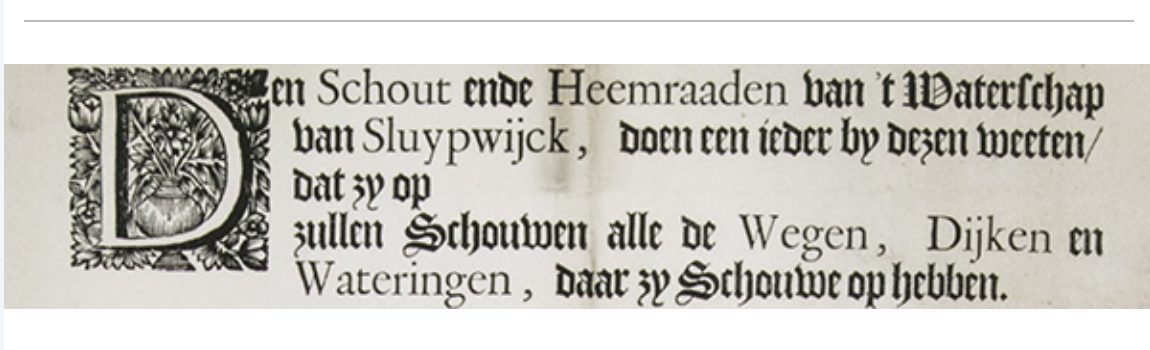

First edition of a rare document printed in Lima with news of the death of Melchor Navarra y Rocafull, more widely known as the jure uxoris Duque de la Palata (1626-1691); the letter is written in the form of praise, by an anonymous party and addressed to a gentleman from Lima, whom in turn had it printed. It describes the process of the Duke's sickness and attempts to cure him, prior to ecclesiastical preparation for his death, at three thirty in the afternoon on April 13, 1691. Melchor de Navarra was a military officer and Spanish colonial officer; he reached the pinnacle of his career in the Indies when appointed Viceroy of Peru (1681-1689).

Remarkable broadside offering insight into 18th-century water management in a Dutch peat cutting area



[BROADSIDE - WATER MANAGEMENT - SLUIPWILK].
Waerschouwinge. Den schout ende heemraaden van 't waterschap van Sluypwijck, doen een ieder by desen weten dat zy op zullen schouwen alle de wegen, dijken en wateringen, daar zy schouwe op hebben.

[Gouda?, second half of the 18th century]. Ca. 46 x 35.5 cm.
Remarkable, unrecorded broadside, relating to Dutch water management in Sluipwijk (near Gouda) in the 18th century. This official publication from the water authority of Sluipwijk (waterschap Sluipwijk) informs landowners whose properties include a part of a dike or a body of the water of the latest regulations. In particular, it calls them to remove rubbish and weeds from the waterways, gives the exact width and depth that some of the ditches needed to be, and tells them to even out holes and wheel tracks on the dikes and roads.

[BROADSIDE - DELFT].
Publicatie tot redding van drenckelingen.

Delft, Adrianus Sterck, 2 February 1769. Ca. 54 x 43.5 cm.

Remarkable, unrecorded broadside informing the citizens of Delft of the best ways to save drowned people. Apparently, recovered drown victims that showed no signs of life were typically left on the waterfront with their feet dipped into the water. However, the present broadside (or "plakkaat" in Dutch) states that they had to be brought to the nearest house or inn instead, where a physician had to be called as soon as possible, as the victim might still be alive. The broadside was sent to every inn within the jurisdiction of Delft at the time, so it must have been printed many times. However, it is now exceptionally rare, as we have not been able to trace any other copies.

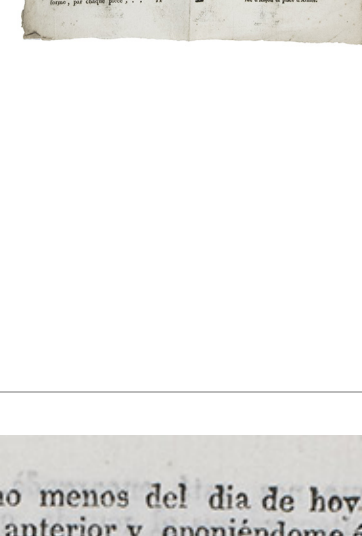

One of the final laws of the French administration on Haiti before the island's independence

[HAITI].
Taxe d'absence. Extraits des registres du conseil des notables de la Ville du Cap. Séance du 27 Vendémiaire, an douze (20 Octobre 1803) neuf heures du matin.

Rare broadsheet printed in Haiti, at Cap-Français (now Cap-Haïtien), at the north coast of the island, with an announcement by the French public council of the island to levy a tax of absence, penalizing the property owners of the city of Cap(-Français) who had left the colony, leaving their homes unoccupied. This decree was issued under command of the French colonial authorities, Donatien de Rochambeau (1755-1813), general chef; Fontaine (dates unknown), secretary general; and Voisin (dates unknown), maritime and colonial inspector, just a month before the decisive defeat of the French army by Jean-Jacques Dessalines (1758-1806) on the 18th of November 1803. Dessalines became Haiti's first ruler after its declaration of Independence on the first of January 1804.



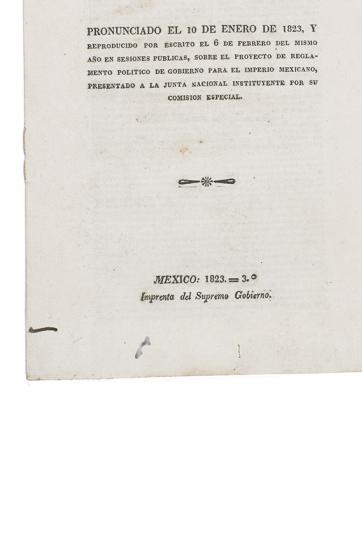

One of the foundational texts for the 1824 Mexican Constitution

[MEXICO - José María BOCANEGRA].
Discurso del diputado Bocanegra. Pronunciado el 10 de enero de 1823, y reproducido por escrito el 6 de febrero del mismo año en sesiones publicas, sobre el proyecto de reglamento politico de gobierno para el imperio Mexicano, presentado a la junta nacional instituyente por su comision especial.

Very rare first edition of an important speech, which forms part of the preliminary draft of the 1824 Mexican Constitution. It was delivered by José María Bocanegra (1787-1862), a notable lawyer and politician, on January 10, 1823, during the public sessions of the National Institutional Junta. This Junta has been installed by the controversial Emperor Agustín I (1783-1824) after he had dissolved congress in November 1822. Bocanegra opposed the emperor and his actions. In the speech, he therefore presents the "Proyecto de Reglamento Politico para el Imperio Mexicano", a political framework that aimed to define the political structure of the newly independent country. Bocanegra's vision significantly influenced the debates that eventually led to the drafting of Mexico's Constitution of 1824. The present speech is therefore recognised as one of the foundational texts for its creation.

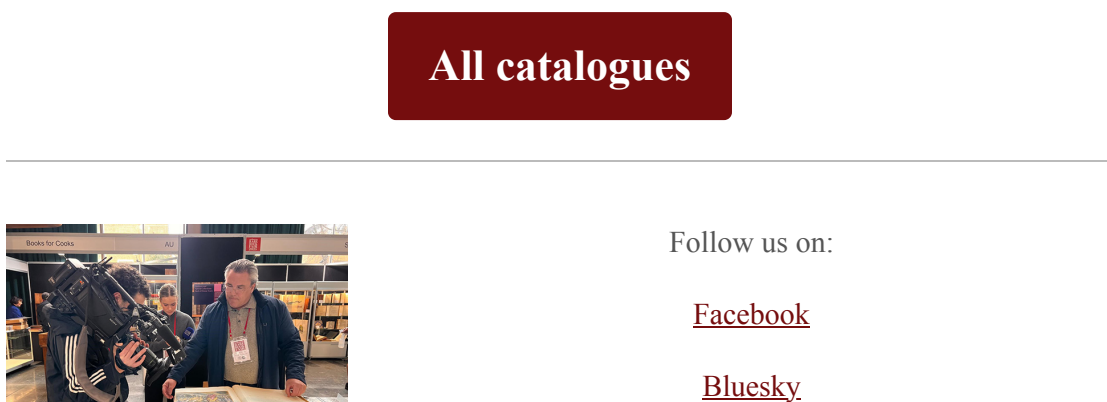

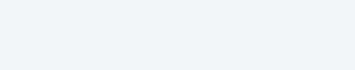
